- SPC-5 - SCSI Primary Commands completed a Request for Comment ballot and comment resolution completed at this meeting a final document will be available at the next meeting for a letter ballot towards first public review.
- SRP-2 SCSI RDMA Protocol - 2 completed an RFC ballot. There are a few ballot comments remaining to be resolved.

New Project Proposal

- SPC-6 SCSI Primary Commands - 6 project proposal was forwarded to INCITS for approval
- SAS 4.1 Serial Attach SCSI - 4.1 project proposal was forwarded to INCITS for approval (this will remove some of the speed requirements in SAS-4 without adding any new speed requirements)

Other T10 work

- SBC-4r16 is the latest revision and contains all proposals to date. There is one proposal being processed that has some minor affect on SBC-4; however, it is expected that a RFC Ballot will be started following the March plenary meeting.
- SAM-6 and SES-4 are close to final input and the plan for RFC ballots on these two standards will be discussed at the next plenary meeting.
- FCP-5 was discussed and it was asked that a conference call be scheduled with Dave Peterson, Kevin Butt, and Curtis Ballard (at a minimum) be scheduled to determine the requirement for the proposed correction that Dave Peterson presented. This conference call is to be announced via the T10 reflector 2 weeks prior to the meeting.
