The T11 committee voted to recommend the following standards or technical reports for Reaffirmation or Stabilization during the April 2020 plenary meeting. The motions are captured in clause 15.1 of the April 2020 draft minutes (T11-2020-00095-v000).

Motion 1: Steve Wilson (Broadcom) moves and Roger Hathorn (IBM) seconds that the following standards be recommended for Stabilization (2/3 Meeting). The rationale for stabilization is that the standards have ongoing validity and effectiveness, but they are mature and unlikely to require maintenance of any sort. The motion passed with 17 favoring, 0 opposing, and 0 abstaining.
