The T11 committee voted to recommend the following standards or technical reports for Reaffirmation or Stabilization during the February 2021 plenary meeting. The motions are captured in clause 15.1 of the February 2021 draft minutes (T11-2021-00049-v000).

Motion 1: Steve Wilson (Broadcom) moves and Jason Rusch (Viavi) seconds that the following standards be recommended for Stabilization (2/3 Meeting). The rationale for stabilization is that the standards have ongoing validity and effectiveness, but they are mature and unlikely to require maintenance of any sort.
