Minutes Fibre Channel Protocol (T11.3) Task Group plenary meeting #155 2023 December 07 - 10:30AM to 11:30AM EST Deerfield Beach, FL + **Virtual Meeting**

1 Opening remarks and introductions

The Chair convened plenary meeting #155 of the Fibre Channel Protocol (T11.3) Task Group on 2023 December 07 at 10:30 EST. He introduced himself as Roger Hathorn (IBM), and the group thanked Amphenol for the hotel arrangements. The role of the Vice-Chair is vacant at the moment. Patty Driever (IBM) introduced herself as secretary. Members present and on Zoom introduced themselves.

Approval of the Agenda 2

An electronic version of the agenda, T11-2023-00376-v000, and supporting documents were made available among the documents for this meeting. The agenda was in HTML format with links to the appropriate supporting documents. The chair presented the agenda and made a call for any new agenda items. No new items were requested.

David Peterson (Broadcom) moved and DJ Brown (Dell) seconded that T11-2023-00376-v001 be approved as posted as the agenda for this meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

3 Administrative Matters

3.1 T11.3 Admin Is Trivia
