Minutes

T11.3 FC-FS-7 ad hoc work group regular meeting 03 April 2024 – 03:00PM – 05:00PM EDT Savannah, GA (Hybrid)

The FC-FS-7 ad hoc work group of the Fibre Channel Protocol (T11.3) Task Group held a regular meeting in Savannah, GA hosted by Amphenol along with virtual conferencing facilities using the Zoom platform on 03 April 2024. Attendance was 12 people from 9 organizations and is tabulated at the end of this document.

1 Opening remarks & Introductions

Chairperson Raul Oteyza (Marvell) opened the regular meeting Wednesday, 03 April 2024 at 02:32 PM EDT. He thanked our in-person host organization, Amphenol, and then led a round of introductions.

1.1 Attendance and Membership

The chair explained that attendance is recorded electronically at www.incits.org and explained the procedure. Attendance at this meeting does not count toward attendance at the plenaries of T11 and its task groups (i.e., being here will not get you out or keep you out of membership jeopardy). Again this was done prior to Anil's presentation, but he reviewed the changes included in this presentation. Based on what Anil showed, some additional changes are needed beyond what is in this doc (e.g. Table 16 needs significant change). He will go back and make needed changes to the text so that it is compatible with Anil's presentation. We won't likely incorporate this for a while...it will be a working document that will follow progress in FC-PI-9.
