Thank you for your public review comment on BSR INCITS 510, "Fibre Channel Generic Services 7 (FC-GS-7)" revision 10.7.

The comment we received from you is listed below:

1. The definitions of the Port Speed Capabilities and Port Operating Speeds are inconsistent and cannot be

implemented as described in FC-GS-7.

The T11 committee has determined that the comment is technical. The committee then approved the following resolution for the comment during the INCITS T11 Technical Committee Meeting #136 on August 4, 2016 in Saint Paul, MN.

The resolution to Comment 1 was addressed at the August 2016 meeting and a solution agreed upon. The updated document that includes the resolution is Fibre Channel Generic Services 7 (FC-GS-7) revision 10.8. ## **Appeals Process**

- 1) You may appeal an action of INCITS or its Secretariat; the INCITS Appeals Procedures are in Section 5.4 of the INCITS Procedures.
- 2) Notification of the Right to Appeal to the ANSI Board of Standards Review (http://www.ansi.org/standards\_activities/domestic\_programs/appeals/appeals.aspx?menuid=3). In accordance with BSR Procedures, those objecting to the approvals or withdrawals are hereby notified of their right of appeal. The appeal must be based on due process or lack of consensus and include a statement as to why the BSR action should be modified. The BSR will not render decisions on the relative merits of technical matters, but it shall consider whether due process was afforded technical concerns.

Note: If you have not completed the appeals process at the standards developer, you are normally not eligible to appeal to the BSR.
