Dear Rachel,

The T11 committee voted to recommend the following standards or technical reports for Reaffirmation or Stabilization at the February 2013 plenary meeting. The committee was first made aware of the 2013 national maintenance review at the December 2012 T11 plenary meeting.

Motion 1: Steve Wilson (Brocade) moved and Lou Ricci (EMC) seconded that T11 recommend the following standards or technical reports for Stabilization. The reason for Stabilization is that these standards address mature technology or practices, and as a result they are not likely to require revision. In addition, the standards are not safety or health related. INCITS RD-2 requires approval of this question in accord with the 2/3 rule as determined by roll call vote. The motion passed with 22 Favoring, 0 Opposing, 0 Abstaining, 6 Not Voting, which met the 2/3 rule.
